SPRINT FOR CANCER OVER THE YEARS

In 2003, NCR employees came together with the goal of creating a charitable event that everyone could rally around. These employees realized that in some way, everyone is impacted by cancer, leading to the birth of the Sprint for Cancer race and the goal of raising as much money as possible for cancer-related causes. Today, more than 2,200 racers and volunteers across the country take part in the event. This year marks the 10th anniversary of our first Sprint for Cancer race and our goal is to surpass \$1 million in total contributions across our 10 years of giving.

2003: At the first race, Radiant employees, families and friends ran in the parking lot of the company headquarters.

2005-2006: Sprint for Cancer keeps growing and moves to Atlantic Station, a shopping district in Atlanta.

2007: The first year Sprint for Cancer raises more than \$100,000!

2008: Highest fundraising total to date: \$134,000!

2009: Sprint for Cancer expands. A second race is launched in Dallas/Fort Worth, benefiting Young Texans Against Cancer.

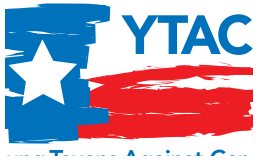
2010: California offices join the effort! Radiant sponsors the Pediatric Cancer Research Foundation's Cinco de Mayo race and employees run as a team. In total, all three Sprint for Cancer events raise more than \$150,000 for cancer causes.

2011: Sprint for Cancer raises nearly \$200,000 to support cancer causes across the country.

2012: Sprint for Cancer sets a goal to surpass \$1 million in total contributions across 10 years of giving.
